Dismounted Counter-IED Tactics Master Trainer (DCT-MT)

What is the DCT- MT?

It is a two week course that prepares dismounted C-IED Master Trainers to integrate training, advise leaders on threat assessments, and plan tactical employment of enablers to counter IED related threats targeting dismounted patrols.



IT TRAINS PATROL LEADERS TO:

- Understand threat TTP's and the methodology used to target dismounted patrols.
- Incorporate dismounted maneuver tactics in an IED environment with TTP's gathered from theater.
- Plan tactical employment of enablers to counter IED related threats targeting dismounted patrols.

IT BUILDS: SMEs at the SFAAT, CO and BN level to advise Commanders on the tactical employment of C-IED enablers to support dismounted operations.

What does DCT- MT consist of?

The course is conducted in 2 phases over 10 days at **no cost** to the unit:

- **Phase I** (Conducted by DCT-MT Team) – Classroom instruction on tactical theory regarding enabler employment during dismounted patrols.
- **Phase II** (Conducted by DCT-MT Team) – Patrol Planning and Practical Evaluations focused on the tactical application of dismounted enablers.

Who is this course targeted to?

- **Deploying units, RAF and GRF**

Who should get the training?

- **Combat arms patrol leaders** who will be actively conducting dismounted combat patrols in an IED environment
- **SFAAT leaders**
- NCOs identified by their chain of command as dismounted **C-IED trainers**.
- **Class size is limited to 15-27 students.**



Prerequisites:



- Hold the rank of SGT (P) and above.
- Units will provide a memorandum certifying completion of the CI2C's Operator Course (VMR-2 (Minehound), DSP-27, VMC-1 (Gizmo), THOR III) or completion of a unit level operator training course.
- Secret Security Clearance or an Interim Secret Security Clearance.

*** DCT-MT students must meet the prerequisites before starting the course.**
