SUBJECT: Standard Mission Essential Task Lists (METL)

- 1. Reference ADP 7-0, Training Units and Developing Leaders, Aug 12.
- 2. The Army adopts Standard Decisive Action METLs for like type units at echelons down through Company level, to enable Commanders to more accurately and objectively build and assess training readiness, and ensure that like units are reporting readiness on the same capabilities. A unit's METL represents the doctrinal framework of fundamental collective tasks (Mission Essential Tasks and associated Supporting Collective Tasks) for which the unit was designed in order to perform Decisive Action in support of Unified Land Operations.
- 3. This memorandum promulgates the initial group of Headquarters, Department of the Army (HQDA) approved Standard METLs (enclosed) resulting from the Training General Officer Steering Committee (TGOSC) 16-01. Units within your command can begin to utilize these Standard METLs immediately to focus their training. The readiness reporting system (NetUSR) will incorporate these approved METLs beginning with the July 2016 reporting period.
- 4. Subsequently, approved METLs will be promulgated through a phased approach using the Army Training Network (ATN) website and the Digital Training Management System (DTMS).
