

Attack the Network Definition

The AtN framework consists of activities that employ lethal and nonlethal means to support friendly networks, influence neutral networks, and neutralize threat networks. AtN is conducted continuously and simultaneously at multiple levels (tactical, operational, and strategic) throughout unified action partner organizations.




Staff Attack the Network MTT

Brigade and below Attack the Network (AtN) Battle Staff training is provided to Army units through MCoE's Mobile Training Team (MTT). The current training emphasis is on IED, Crime and Narcotic networks, however units are starting to request Theater Specific AtN TNG. AtN training is based on the operational framework developed by MCoE:










<u>Key Tasks</u>

- Utilize EDGE to facilitate Attack the Network Training and provide simulated Operational Environment to enhance training

Enhanced Dynamic Geo-Social Environment (EDGE)

- Immersive simulation based on Unreal game engine (Unreal ver. 3)
- Single player or networked multi-player teams
- Based on AtN Doctrine: Support, Influence, Neutralize (SIN)
- Focused on the 6 Pillars of AtN
- Object is for player to interact with the environment and Non-Player Characters (avatars) to make decisions based on AtN doctrine and Commander's Intent for the mission.



Enhanced Dynamic Geo-Social Environment Virtual PE Process



Soldiers interact with over 20 different virtual villagers. AtN-related actions include:

- Identifying villagers as friendly, neutral or threat.
- Reviewing intelligence/results from previous day(s) operations.
- Making decisions on conducting new operations.
- Employing available enablers to gain and exploit information on local networks.
- Best decisions result in best outcomes along SIN Lines of Effort
