TCM-Recon priority of effort this week is supporting Unified Challenge 16.1 activities (14-24 and 28-31 MAR) at Fort Leavenworth and Fort Benning and R&S BCT initial mission analysis. Additionally, efforts continue on the R&S CBA Functional Solutions Analysis (FSA), CATR integration focusing on training development, and support to Army Management Action Group (AMAG) IPRs 17, 21, and 25 MAR IPRs..

2. RECON.

a. R&S Concepts and Analysis:

1) R&S BCT O&O Implementation: We conducted initial discussions with with DOTD to review and update the draft R&S BCT METL based on METL development changes that have been implemented since the draft METL was developed in 2014. We have a follow-up session on Friday with TCM-Stryker to discuss the way ahead and prepare for the ARCIC Director's visit next week where R&S BCT actions will be discussed. The updated draft R&S BCT O&O reflecting K series TOEs was provided to ARCIC and FORSCOM this week.

2) CAV SQDN O&O: The CAV SQDN O&O was approved by ARCIC on 29 FEB 16. The approved O&O has been posted to the Recon Knowledge Network and is being distro'd as requests are received.

3) Scout PLT O&O: Writing the O&O will begin in APR upon completion of UC 16. 1. Major RFIs related to writing the O&O include scout squad definition and developing a scout sniper concept and cannot be addressed until APR.

4) R&S CBA: The Functional Solutions Analysis (FSA) is begin updated based on initial CoAR review and guidance on 2 MAR in preparation for the next CoAR review on 29 MAR.

b. CATR:

1) CATR O&O: Review of the initial draft of CATR O&O continues. The O&O will support the development of the training strategy and efforts with PdM.

2) CATR Lesson Plans: Continuing to support the development of CATR overview and tagging tracking and locating lessons plans. Continuing to support the development of CATR critical task list.

3) CATR integration into functional courses: ICW with CATR Master Trainer continuing discussions with instructors from RSLC and Sniper course to determine a way

ahead to incorporate familiarization training. Conducted office call with ARC course manager.

4) CATR BOIP: Adjudicating comments from USASOC and USAFMSA.
