FY16 Combined Arms Futures Integrated Exercise (CAFIX): TCM-Soldier SFDF is executing the FY16 Combined Arms Future Integration Exercise (CAFIX) series of focused assessments. Technologies assessed include fuel cells, micro-Doppler radar, an integration of Soldier Borne Sensors in the scout section, and others still in development. CAFIX is a MCoE led effort of collaborative futures integration with Defense Advanced Research Projects Agency (DARPA), Natick Soldier Research, Development and Engineering Center (NSRDEC), Army Aviation and Missile Research, Development and Engineering Center (AMRDEC), and other collaborating partners. CAFIX focuses on the integration of future warfighting capabilities in order to inform requirements and enable combined arms capability development for Soldiers and small units.
