- 1. (FOUO) I WANT TO MAKE SURE ALL UNITED STATES ARMY SOLDIERS ARE AWARE OF A RECENTLY APPROVED MODIFICATION TO THE M-ATV WITH UIK-2 THAT THE JOINT PROGRAM OFFICE IS PREPARING TO IMPLEMENT.
- 2. (FOUO) THE THEATER HAS RECOMMENDED A MODIFICATION TO THE M-ATV EXHAUST PORT. THE ARMY INTENDS TO FIELD A PATCH ON THE M-ATV EXHAUST PORT IN RESPONSE TO THIS RECOMMENDATION TO ADDRESS A POTENTIAL UNIQUE OVERMATCH VULNERABILITY AND FURTHER INCREASE SOLDIER CONFIDENCE IN THE VEHICLE. TESTING CONTINUES TO SHOW THAT THE M-ATV IS NOT VULNERABLE TO OVERPRESSURE AND PERFORMS WELL AGAINST THREATS THAT FAR EXCEED THE PERFORMANCE DESIGN OF THE VEHICLE.
- 3. (FOUO) THE ARMY WELCOMES SUGGESTIONS FROM THE FIELD AS WE CONTINUE TO TEST AND IMPROVE THE M-ATV AGAINST THREATS BEYOND ITS INITIAL DESIGN. WE WILL CONTINUE TO EXAMINE NEW THREATS AND UNIQUE ENVIRONMENTAL CONDITIONS TO ENSURE OUR SOLDIERS HAVE THE BEST PROTECTION.
