EIR DIGEST NEWS ARTICLE

Starting in April 2016, the EIR Digest will be available on LOTTIS Home Page under EIR Digest Tab. Below is an article written by Rob Nagel, Chief, Publications Services Team, TACOM, describing what the EIR Digest is all about:

In December 2009, TACOM published the final issue of the Equipment Improvement Report and Maintenance Digest. This quarterly bulletin, issued since the 1970s, covered all categories of equipment (including some used by other services) managed by the TACOM Life Cycle Management Command. It contained information on EIRs, Equipment Publication Changes, MWOs, Warranty/Recall information, and publication actions, some resulting from DA Form 2028 (Recommended Changes to Publications and Blank Forms) submittals.

Since last summer, TACOM's EPCO has explored the possibility of resurrecting the Digest, especially after insightful discussions with Matthew Caputo, Senior Maintenance Advisor and USAREUR Maintenance Advisor. Prior issues of the Digest were mainly produced by an outside contractor, and the cost of that effort was one of the main reasons the Digest was abandoned after 2009. This time, the Digest will be compiled and produced inhouse by EPCO staff. Although certainly labor-intensive, having control over its development will ensure accuracy while saving taxpayer money.

The first issue of the resurrected EIR Digest, TB 43-0001-62-16-1, will come out sometime this April after it is authenticated by the Army Publishing Directorate (APD). It will cover the period of JAN through MAR 2016 (IQCY16). Issues thereafter will come out quarterly. Each issue of the Digest will expire two years after its publication date.

The Digest will contain the following chapters:

- I. General information
- 2. EIR Cases
- 3. Minor Alterations
- 4. DA Forms 2028 (Approved for Implementation)
- 5. Miscellaneous Technical Information
- 6. Technical Equipment Publications Authenticated
- 7. Safety and Maintenance Messages

The EIR Cases chapter, the original basis for the Digest, will address EIR cases that have been assessed for causes of deficiency, design, quality assurance, maintenance, and contractor liability. It is strongly recommended that NSNs in addition to part numbers and FSCs be included wherever possible-not only in this chapter but throughout the Digest-to prevent soldiers and other users from having to perform any cross-referencing.

The Minor Alterations chapter will contain articles that strictly adhere to the minor alterations policy as set down in paragraph 3-3 in AR 750-10. Any information that does not adhere to this stated policy will not be considered for inclusion in the Digest.

The DA Forms 2028 chapter will include all those 2028s responded to during the quarter in which concurrence was sent to the 2028 submitter.

The Miscellaneous Technical Information chapter will include articles containing technical and maintenance information not formally generated by EIR case studies, but resulting from engineering tests, design activities, depot operations, and support maintenance activities. This information is more informative than directive.

The last two chapters will merely be lists of the publications authenticated and the AESMSN messages released that quarter. Although this information may be found on LOGSA's ETMs Online Web site and TULSA, we believe having it compiled in one publication may be beneficial.

** PLEASE NOTE: Information in the Digest is informational in scope. Compliance is optional at the user's prerogative and expense. The Digest contains discretionary entries, authorizes certain maintenance actions, and gives advance information on pending changes to equipment publications. It is recommended that advance information on changes to maintenance publications, unless identified specifically as informational, be annotated in the appropriate publication and implemented immediately. The Digest will not be used to circumvent the proper publications process, such as submitting detailed Work Packages for inclusion in a TM that should be handled through the normal change package authentication process.


