### G-4 News—Army Oil Analysis Program

The Medium Trailer Mounted Support System (MED TMSS) NSN DLA 8340-01-533 -5344 or CECOM NSN 6115-01-547-6738, and Large Trailer Mounted Support System (LG TMSS) NSN DLA 8340-01-537-8710 or CECOM 6115-01-547-8513 are now required to enroll in the Army Oil Analysis Program (AOAP). Oil Analysis Program (AOPE) sample every 500 run hours or every 90 days, whichever comes first as required in ALARACT 330-1201. Units with this equipment are to enroll in the AOAP and provide required samples to their supporting AOAP Laboratory. The AOAP LAB will provide information to the unit when to change oil in the TMSS Generators and when there are problems internal to the engine and recommended actions for internal engine problems.
