SFDF Updates

- Maneuver and Fires Integrated Exercise (MFIX): Fires CoE, ARCIC FA-T and SFDF are
 developing the FY15 SFDF-Focused Assessment. MFIX Phase I is scheduled for Jul 2015 at
 Fort Sill focused on target location & identification, Command & Control (C2)/data sharing,
 protection (countering unmanned aerial systems) and weapon & munitions system capabilities.
 MFIX Phase II is focused on Preemptive Threat Detection and Identification and is scheduled
 for April 2016.
- **Squad Overmatch Study:** Squad Overmatch Study: DOTD MCoE will sponsor an Army SFDF FY15 study titled: "Cost of Achieving Squad Overmatch by Training Resilience and Situational Awareness Skills that Optimize Human Performance and Discourage PTS and Suicide".

- Article: Aerial resupply lands on ground troops: The U.S. Army is streamlining efforts to provide squad- and platoon-level ground Soldiers, operating in austere environments, with an organic aerial resupply capability that will empower and sustain them on the battlefield. (View Article)
- Article: Army Warfighter Experiment highlights new technologies: Three Army technologies were in play at the recently conducted Army Expeditionary Warfighter Experiment, or AEWE, on Fort Benning, Georgia. U.S. Army Aviation and Missile Research, Development and Engineering Center, also known as AMRDEC, technologies participating in spiral "J" included the TowerHawk weapons system, Containerized Weapons System, and the Maneuver Aviation Fires Integrated Application, also known as MAFIA. - Article: Army realigns tactical network initialization process for increased efficiency:
 Turn on a new computer for the first time and you are met with a few questions before the computer is registered and recognized. In Army command posts, Soldiers must also complete this initialization step when their communications hardware is first turned on, so it can recognize and exchange critical information with other systems across the battlefield. - Article: Army researchers return to Norway for nutrition, cold-stress study in Arctic extremes: The U.S. Army Research Institute of Environmental Medicine, or USARIEM, once again partnered with the Norwegian Defence Research Establishment to study nutrition and physiological responses to cold-weather training.  of their surroundings, squids are masters of camouflage, blending in to the scenery to avoid

- Article: Combat rations database allows Soldiers to learn about meals, ready-to-eat nutrition: The new online combat rations database, or ComRaD, formally launched earlier this month by the Department of Defense's Human Performance Resource Center, or HPRC, provides warfighters, military dietitians, food service officers and leaders the opportunity to learn more about the nutritional value of what is inside those packages.
