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Ath Operations

The AtN/Network Engagement Operations Team is the TRADOC Line of Effort lead for maintaining and executing Annex C of the TRADOC C-IED Campaign Plan. The team provides TRADOC with an assessment of progress related to AtN/Network Engagement doctrine development, integration, training, and education, and provides operational support to Doctrine Development and the Staff Attack the Network MTT. The Operations Team is the POC for scheduling Staff Attack the Network Training.

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Integration Office

Develops, integrates, and provides relevant C-IED training; program support; training aids; Program of Instruction support; subject matter expertise; strategies to enhance the survivability of U.S. forces; Attack the Network (AtN)/Network Engagement doctrine; training strategies; programs; material solutions; and products to enhance the combat effectiveness of the current and future Army, Reconnaissance/Cavalry, and Infantry forces.

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Fort Benning CIED Training Support Team



Provides the following training focus/intent and enablers for requesting commanders and units.

- 1. Delivers CIED training for IET Soldiers IAW TRADOC mandated tasks
- 2. IED Professional Development
- 3. C-IED enablers training and familiarization
- 4. Data Collection/Soldier Survey topics

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Dismounted C-IED Tactics Master Trainer (DCT-MT)



The DCT-MT course is 10 days (80 hours) in length and culminates in the completion of situational training exercise (STX). The class size is a minimum of 15 students and a maximum of 30 students; ranges and equipment will ultimately determine the size of the class.

The course is conducted in 2 phases over 10 days at **no cost** to the unit

Course Objective

Upon completion of this course, the Master Trainer (MT) will have the foundation to become an SME in CIED TTPs. The MT will apply knowledge to assist leaders with C-IED training, planning, executing, and supervising at company/battalion level. The MT will advise unit leaders and personnel about IED threats, recommend enablers to mitigate IED threats, incorporate C-IED TTPs into the Unit Training Plan, conduct a company level C-IED training program.

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MCoE STAFF Attack the Network MTT



The Staff Attack the Network(AtN)/Network Engagement MTT consists of 10 lessons, 5 STAFFEXs and a Virtual Simulation Capstone Exercise called the Enhanced Dynamic Geo-Social Environment (EDGE). The ten lessons provide tools and considerations that help units to effectively engage threat networks. EDGE is a computer-based simulation which uses an AtN/Network Engagement scenario designed to establish a virtual practical exercise after Soldiers have already received days 1 & 2 of training on AtN/Network Engagement concepts, doctrine, and principles. Training is conducted at **NO COST** to the unit.

The TSP lessons are as follows:
