## Tactical Decision Exercise

- Participants are broken into four groups
- Each group designates a group leader
- TDE mimics MIBT operations at Fort Riley, KS
- CPT Kirbyson issues the instructions

  - Groups develop a COA sketch and prepare to brief
- Minimum of two groups are chosen to brief their COA
  - COAs are critiqued by non-briefing groups to generate discussion
