### SFDF Updates

- Maneuver and Fires Integrated Exercise (MFIX): SFDF is planning the FY15 MFIX Phase II LOE, scheduled for Aug 2015 at Fort Benning. FY15 Phase II LOE will focus on Preemptive Threat Detection and Identification.
- Squad Overmatch Study: Squad Overmatch Study: DOTD MCoE will sponsor an Army SFDF FY15 study titled: "Cost of Achieving Squad Overmatch by Training Resilience and Situational Awareness Skills that Optimize Human Performance and Discourage PTS and Suicide".

- <u>Article: Mobile app to diagnose head injuries scores FDA clearance:</u> The new Defense Automated Neurobehavioral Assessment is a mobile phone-based application designed to help medical providers identify cases of traumatic brain injury in almost any setting, which may help clinicians diagnose a patient in as little as five minutes. - <u>Article: Army conducts base camp technology demonstrations:</u> Army researchers recently completed Demonstration 1, the first in a series of demonstrations looking at energy-saving technologies, which will reduce the fuel, water demands and the waste generated for backhaul currently experienced at small base camps in forward operational environments. - <u>Article: First Strike Ration® (FSR):</u> The First Strike Ration® (FSR) is a compact, eat-onthe-move assault ration designed for use in high intensity combat operations, or similar training scenarios, for up to 10 days as a sole source of subsistence. - <u>Article: Picatinny lightens Soldiers' load, shaves 12 pounds off mortar system:</u> Following the successful fielding of the lightweight 60mm mortar system, Picatinny has begun delivering the new lightweight 81mm system to troops. The new M252A1 81mm system is 12 pounds, or 14 percent, lighter than its predecessor, the legacy M252 mortar system. (View Article)
