

- Can execute up to six rotations simultaneously
  - 6 Teams of 5 Contractor O/Ts and an OPFOR Commander
- Is a tailored program based on training objectives and unit needs:
  - Single mission scenarios
  - MDMP focused STAFFEX at home station over a MUTA 5 / 6 period
  - JANUS supported SIMEX with multiple iterations conducted over a MUTA 5 / 6 period
- The program incorporates existing resources (DBSP, COTAs and existing facilities) for home stationbased training
- Does not compete with other programs (e.g., CTCs and TSXXI)
- Training feedback and distributed training trends to the field via web, quarterly training bulletin and CALL





Provides realistic, stressful, combined arms training and leader development for ARNG battalions and other selected units, in order to provide trained and ready battalions that can fight and win decisively as part of a brigade or division and conduct full spectrum operations worldwide.

## BATTALION STAFF TRAINING PROGRAM



OBJECTIVE

The Battalion Staff Training Program (BSTP) provides an opportunity to develop and apply war fighting skills in staff planning exercises (STAFFEX) and constructive/simulation supported exercises (SIMEX) for Army National Guard battalions to help meet requirements of conducting simulation supported command and staff training annually, as prescribed by ARFORGEN.



The principal executing arm of the BSTP is the Battalion Staff Training Team (BSTT). The mobile training teams of the BSTT execute up to six battalion rotations simultaneously with training tailored to commander objectives. By providing on-site MDMP staff planning exercises (STAFFEX) and single-mission, simulation supported full-spectrum scenario training at unit home stations over a MUTA-5 / 6 period, the BSTT supports available unit training time and provides critical battle staff training to enhance warfighting skills.


- Program designed to assist battalions preparing for deployment BCBST and other major training events including XCTC
- Program flexible to address unit scheduling challenges and individual unit training needs
- Battalion Staff Training Team (BSTT) deploys to unit and or nearest DBSP foot-printed Simulation Center
- Collaborates for resources with NGB's Battle Command Training Capability Program
- BSTP is a sign-up program; not mandatory



#### Units have option of conducting events at BCTC or home station

- Priority of Scheduling:
  - 1. Deployment Expeditionary Force Battalions
  - 2. CBRNE Consequence Management Response Force Battalions
  - **3.** Battalions preparing for Brigade Command and Battle Staff Training program
  - **4.** Battalions of units participating in eXportable Combat Training Capability program
  - 5. Other Battalions as available
- BSTP requires 90 days lead-time to prepare for units/events
- BSTP scheduling is accomplished through:
  - ARNG scheduling conferences
  - Unit COTAs
  - BCTC Operations
