AWfF SENIOR MENTOR SYMPOSIUM 02-2012 29 JUNE 2012, 0930-1100 CDT MEMORANDUM OF INSTRUCTION CHANGE 2

Purpose

The 24th Armored BCT Warfighters' Forum (AWfF) Senior Mentor Symposium, hosted by the ABCT Senior Mentor, LTG Donald Campbell, Jr., Commanding General, III Corps and Fort Hood, TX and CSM Arthur Coleman, Jr., III Corps and Fort Hood CSM, will convene **Friday, 29 June 2012, 0930-1100 (1430Z – 1600Z) Central Daylight Time (CDT)**. The general theme of this symposium will be "Getting Back to Basics".

The ongoing purpose of the symposium is to provide a recurring venue for ABCT Commanders and ABCT community leaders to engage in topics of interest; discuss best practices for meeting the challenges of Unified Land Operations; and share valuable observations, insights and lessons to improve the full range of military operational readiness and assist ABCTs with influencing institutional change.

Symposium Topics

Topic #3: "The Network Enabled Company and Troop XO", Mr. John Miller, Deputy Director, TRADOC Capabilities Manager-Armored Brigade Combat Team (TCM-ABCT).

Topic #4: "Decisive Action Rotational Lessons Learned", Presenter TBD, National Training Center – followed by discussions on ABCT Mounted Maneuver competencies.

Topic #5: "ABCT Fires Battalion EXEVAL (CT XVIII) – A Way", COL Douglas Cardinale, Cdr, 2/3 ID – followed by discussions on strategies for reviving ABCT Core Competencies to execute Combined Arms Maneuver.

Symposium Specific

The symposium will use the Defense Connect Online-Secret (DCO-S) Adobe Connect Enterprise Server. Participants will need access to a Secret Internet Protocol Router Network (SIPRNet) computer and become familiar with Adobe Connect capabilities in order to participate.

Prior to the AWfF Symposium, there will be one connectivity test to verify your systems can connect to the DCO-S session and confirm that audio/speaker capability work properly. All Participants are highly encouraged to use this test prior to the actual symposium.

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Presenter Instructions

Presentations are due to AWfF staff NLT 21 June (Finals) 2012. All slides in the presentation must be clearly marked with classification levels and with any appropriate authorized control markings IAW AR 380-5 and originators local policy. Otherwise, unmarked slides will be treated as SECRET/NOFORN.

- On the designated Presenter Rehearsal Day (27 June), Presenters or their designated representative will perform an online review of their presentation with AWfF NCS from the system they intend to use for the symposium and confirm their provided presentations meet expectations. Presenters will also confirm their contact telephone numbers with AWfF NCS for day of the symposium. Use the telephone numbers found in the Help Desk & Contact Info chart on page 2 to contact AWfF POCs on the day of the rehearsal.
- The day of the symposium, presenters shall be logged into the session NLT 45 minutes prior to start time to allow sufficient time for troubleshooting technical issues and conduct a telephonic (land line) call between AWfF and the presenter POC (see Help Desk & Contact Info chart on page 2).
- On the day of the symposium, AWfF NCS will conduct a communication check with all Presenters 15-minutes before symposium start to confirm they are on the session and ready to present.
- On the day of the symposium, Presenters will be prepared to shift presentation times forward or back at the direction of the AWfF Director.

- Using the provided URL, participants will log in to the session "Guest" window and type their rank, first name, last name, duty position, and organization (Please no call signs).
- All Participants are encouraged to collaborate using the voice, Chat, or My Status ICON (found in lower left corner of the screen) capabilities of Adobe Connect.
- Use standard military radio transmission procedures.
- Break lengthy transmissions into smaller sections to minimize latency problems.
- Mute the microphone when not in use to minimize background noise.
- Identify yourself when first speaking and announce end of transmission with "Over" or "Out" so others know your transmission is complete.
