New Requisition Process on DLA's DRASH Repair Parts for the Large or Medium Trailer Mounted Support System (TMSS)

In order to improve the requisition process, DLA established a new process for NSN repair parts, and also for repair parts that do not have an NSN. Requisition document/s can now be sent to e-mail address: SOE order @ dla.mil. Once received, the SOE Order System will process and send the requisition document/s to the New York DRASH Office (NYDO). The NYDO will fill the requirement/s for tent parts only. If the requirement/s is for the large or medium TMSS, the NYDO will send the requirement/s to the Huntsville, Alabama DRASH Office. There are two ways to pay for the parts that are requested.

(a) The first way (if not a System Requisition): The unit will provide a MIPR to SOE prior to placing an order. Information that will be needed is cost of parts that are to be ordered, shipping costs, and DODAAC. The unit must also submit the customer's POC info, which will include name, phone number, fax number, and e-mail address. Once all this is completed, the units can submit requests for needed items, as well as a date of when the items will be required.

The DRASH Company has almost all of the repair parts for the large or medium TMSS. This system consists of the trailer, and an on-board generator that provides power for air conditioning, heating, tent lighting, as well as some power for in-tent equipment for computers, and other electronic devises when the tent is erected. The medium and large trailers have space for a stowed tent, tent parts, trailer equipment, and other power distribution equipment.
