

AMC TACOM ILSC MF&T UTAP In order to better serve our UTAP members and provide them a more robust website, UTAP has been in the process of giving LOTTIS a facelift over the past 8 months. The time has finally arrived that this facelift is just about completed. In order to make it a smooth transition, the final touches will be done in phases throughout September 2016. Below are the key dates for the transition. It is important to note that while transitions are happening behind the scenes the site will still be usable for our customers including viewing and downloading materials.

2 September 2016 – No modifications (add, edit, delete) will be allowed for members info or training materials.

12 September 2016 – New members who sign up between 12 September 2016 and the first week of October 2016, will be put in a holding pattern until the transition is completed. One the transition is completed and the new site is live, the new accounts will be processed.

26-30 September 2016 – LOTTIS will shut down for final migration. For a few days the site will not be accessible to anyone. At this point, if anyone tries to access the site, a notice will appear stating the site is "Under Construction, along with a date when the new site will be available"

3 October 2016 - UTAP is now live. Welcome to our new site!

Along with a summary of major enhancements below, one of the biggest changes is our name. We are dropping the name LOTTIS and transitioning to UTAP, Unit Training Assistance Program. UTAP has been our team name and the name many customers have used for us in the past. Calling the site by our team name aligns the people and product in a way to better serve customers and make it easy to remember who we are and what we do.

Combined Arms Command and Control Trainer Upgrade System

The Combined Arms Command and Control Trainer Upgrade System (CACCTUS) was established as the Combined Arms Staff Trainer (CAST) upgrade program in response to the Required Operational Capability for the CAST; change 2 (NO. TNG 491.4.1) dated 11 Feb 2002. The requirement was based on the Marine Corps' need for a CAST that was capable of providing realistic fire support training for Marine Air-Ground Task Force (MAGTF) elements up to and including the Marine Expeditionary Force (MEF), formerly known as a Marine Amphibious Brigade (MEB) level. The requirements were further refined and validated by the CACCTUS Capability Development Document (CDD) Marine Corps Requirement Oversight Council Decision Memorandum 05-2009, dated 22 Dec 2008. CACCTUS is an unclassified Acquisition Category (ACAT) IV program supporting Milestone C production and deployment operations. CACCTUS is a Mission Assurance Category (MAC) III sensitive program as determined by the system User Representative in accordance with Department of Defense (DoD) Directive 8500.2.

The purpose of the Combined Arms Command and Control Trainer Upgrade System (CACCTUS) is to train elements of a combined arms team to plan, coordinate, and control their assets in an attack on a common target or objective. The system emphasizes the employment of direct fire weapons, artillery, mortars, and naval surface fires in conjunction with air support.

CACCTUS provides the ability to:

- Assist exercise developers in understanding simulation capabilities with respect to training objectives and simulation applications that are necessary to support those objectives.
- Conduct pre-event tests and evaluation of supporting databases and parametric data.
- Create a variety of reports that are generated by the simulation systems employed during exercises.
- Enable comprehensive Marine Corps staff, unit, and team training at home station CAST facilities.
- Operate a variety of computer based simulation models and simulation federations, emphasizing technical expertise over military analysis or MAGTF experience.
- Participate in structured simulation training events/exercises and a simulated rehearsal of operational plans and orders.

The training audience includes:

- Direct Air Support Center
- Fire Direction Center for all MAGTF organized units
- Fire Support Coordination Center
- Tactical Air Command Center
- Tactical Air Control Party, Fire Support Team

CACCTUS is employed at five major CAST training facilities:

- Camp Pendleton, CA, with I Marine Expeditionary Force (MEF)
- Camp Lejeune, NC, with II MEF
- Okinawa, JPN, with III MEF
- Marine Corps Base (MCB) HI, with Marine Forces Pacific
- Twentynine Palms, CA, with the MAGTF Training Command

The CACCTUS System consists of the following system components:

- Simulation System
- 3-D Visualization System
- Communications System (COMMS)
- C4I System
- CACCTUS After Action Review System (CAARS)
- Management and Infrastructure System

Using the system components and simulation capabilities, 2D and 3D visuals, interfaced C4I, synthetic terrain, and an After Action Review (AAR), CAC-CTUS immerses trainees in a realistic, scenario-driven environment.

The simulated scenarios enable commanders and their battle staffs to train or rehearse combined arms tactics, techniques, procedures, and decision-making processes prior to any physical engagement.

In future developments when linked with live, virtual, and constructive (LVC) training systems, CACCTUS will have ability to:

- Include other elements of the Marine Air-Ground Task Force (MAGTF) in larger scale training events up to the Marine Expeditionary Brigade (MEB) level.
- Provide training across LVC training networks through interoperability with appropriate Command, Control, Communication, Computers, and Intelligence (C4I) systems in a training environment.
- Provide simulation support, including support of various interfaces to aid the Government in determining simulation and event subscriber requirements.
- Translate real world or fictional enemy, friendly and neutral task organizations; tables of equipment; supply stocks; and operational orders in exercise simulation databases or scenarios.



Because CACCTUS provides critical combined arms command and control integration and fire support coordination training to units leading up to and just prior to participating in live fire exercises and deployment it provides more realistic training to date, bringing Marines as close to combat as possible without putting them in the line of fire.


