M106 Screening Obscuration Device-Visually Restricted Terrain (SOD-Vr)

Description

- The M106 Screening Obscuration Device-Visually Restrictive Terrain (SOD-Vr) is a BURSTING Smoke hand grenade used for Screening and Concealment.
- The M106 SOD-Vr can be identified by the following:
 - Single Circle Pull Ring seated in a Confidence Clip
 - Double Tooth Spoon (Lever)
 - **Light Green in color** and has a signal **Brown Band** 3/4 of the way down the grenade body of the grenade a **“Low Order Explosive”**
- **“COOK OFF”**: is the intentional releasing of 1/4 pound of pressure, or moving the thumb of the throwing hand greater than 1/8 inch away from the safety lever after safety pin extraction leading to striker rotation, primer contact, and high order detonation.
- **“MILKING”**: is the unintentional releasing of 1/4 pound of pressure, or moving the thumb of the throwing hand greater than 1/8 inch away from the safety lever after safety pin extraction leading to striker rotation, primer contact, and high order detonation.
