TRADOC CAPABILITY MANAGER CHARTER

By my authority as TRADOC Commanding General, I hereby appoint

Colonel Mark A. Fitch

as the TRADOC Capability Manager (TCM) for

Explosive Ordnance Disposal (EOD)

TCM EOD, representing the TRADOC Commanding General (CG) and reporting to the Director, Capabilities Development and Integration Directorate, Combined Arms Support Command and the Sustainment Center of Excellence, acts as TRADOC's centralized manager for capabilities development activities associated with EOD. TCM EOD integrates, synchronizes, and coordinates capability development efforts across doctrine, organization, training, materiel, leadership and education, personnel, facilities, and policy (DOTMLPF-P) areas in support of EOD. TCM EOD is the user's advocate and counterpart to associated program managers during materiel development. Additionally, TCM EOD develops and manages curriculum associated with EOD training.

TCM EOD is responsible for duties outlined in TRADOC Regulation (TR) 71-12, U.S. Army Training and Doctrine Command Capability Management; TR 71-20, Concept Development, Capabilities Determination, and Capabilities Integration; and the enclosed annex. TCM EOD ensures coordination, integration, and development of deliverables to meet Army/organizational timelines through coordination with capability and materiel developers, testers and evaluators, Army commands, and Department of the Army on the execution of DOTMLPF-P solutions and other issues affecting EOD.

TCM EOD, by means of this charter, is hereby delegated the full-line authority of the TRADOC CG for the centralized management of assigned TRADOC responsibilities.

This appointment remains in effect as long as the TCM EOD is assigned, unless responsibilities are modified or the TRADOC CG terminates the position.
